The **Anna Nicole** Show will return for a 13-episode second season in early 2003.

**Woody Harrelson** is tapped to host NBC's Three Stooges' 75th Anniversary Special, a one-hour event celebrating the legendary comic trio via highlights of rare shorts, feature film clips and favorite routines. No air date has been set.

UPN is giving a full-season order to its updated version of **The Twilight Zone**. The show has been performing strongly on Wednesdays.

A two-year-old **Britney Spears** concert recorded at London's Wembley Stadium in late 2000, will air November 23 on pay-per-view.

**Robert Redford** and screenwriter **Larry Gelbart** are hatching a sequel to their 1972 political drama **The Candidate**. Redford will reprise his role as idealistic politician **Bill McKay**.

Popular arts channel Trio is planning to air classic episodes of **Late Night with David Letterman** starting with a 53-hour Thanksgiving marathon beginning November 28. The reruns officially launch once a week in January.

Filmmakers **Peter** and **Bobby Farrelly** planning to direct **Stuck on You**, a comedy about the adventures of conjoined twins. The brothers are in talks with **Matt Damon** and **Greg Kinnear** to star.

Former Wimbledon champion **Boris Becker** was found guilty of tax evasion but was spared jail by a German court which handed him a two-year suspended sentence and a hefty fine.

Work is clearly going well on the story for the fourth and final **Indiana Jones** film. It's the good **George Lucas-Stephen Spielberg** duo hammering out a new adventure for **Indiana**, once again played by **Harrison Ford**.

The studio behind the Godfather movies will likely have first dibs to the screen rights for a new book about the **Corleone** family. The novel is still on the drawing board, with publisher Random House looking to commission a writer to take over for original author **Mario Puzo**, who died three years ago.

**Harland Braun**, the lawyer who has represented **Robert Blake** since his wife was murdered last year, resigned as Blake's attorney saying that he objected to actor's decision to go on television and discuss his case.

Even though the World Series went seven games, it still may set a record low for televising ratings. Anaheim's thrilling 6-5 comeback win Saturday night received an 11.8 preliminary national rating and 21 share. Fox's six-game average is 24 percent below the first six games last year.

**Linkin Park** is wrapping up work on its sophomore album with producer **Don Gilmore** for an early 2003 release through Warner Bros. Records.

**Andrew W.K.** has been officially tapped to open for **Aerosmith** on the December leg of their Just Push Play tour.

Bad-Boy rocker **Tommy Lee** has been dropped from his label, MCA.
