Warner Bros. is claiming that fans of The Matrix have been downloading copies of the first three Animatrix shorts by the millions on its website www.theanimatrix.com. Nine of the digitally animated films are being produced in advance of the May 15th release of The Matrix Reloaded. All nine are due to be released on DVD on June 3...

The two-year delay of House of 1000 Corpses, **Rob Zombie's** feature-film directorial debut, seems to have whet moviegoers' appetites for the flick's rock-infused gore. The film's opening weekend generated \$3.5 million from just 595 theaters, an impressive \$5,800 per-screen average, ranking it seventh on the latest box-office tally...
