JOE JACKSON'S BAND IS BACK

Joe Jackson has decided to round up his old band and tour this year. "I never thought this would happen," Jackson said. "But at some point, it struck me that 2003 would be our 25th anniversary, which was quite a staggering thought. "We're gonna do quite a big tour and hopefully go to some places that we never got to the first time around. The band is booked solid from mid-March through the beginning of June. They launch their tour in New Orleans and visit select theatres around North America before heading over to Europe, where the band will spend most of their time. Just before Jackson and crew hit the road, the band will put out an album of new tunes. The release of Volume 4 coincides with the 25th anniversary of the recording of Jackson's landmark debut *Look Sharp*. You can catch them in Minneapolis on March 29th at First Avenue. I'm in!
